Thirty-six women gathering at East Park at the Aug. 11 meeting to enjoy a box lunch and hear Dana Andrews, owner of Sturgeon River Pottery, who said the store is celebrating its 40th anniversary this year.



Born and raised in Petoskey, Andrews went to Hope College, majoring in economics and business, and then got an MBA from the University of Michigan. After working in various US cities, he returned to Petoskey in 2011 to help his parents run the store. By 2016 he opened North Goods, located at the corner of



Howard and Lake Streets, which allowed him to expand the family business and tap a different market. Sharing some anecdotes about the store, he recalled how his father decided to sell Bull Frog candles, even though his mother felt they should stick to pottery items. Introducing bird feeders was another project that his father started, and remains a key staple.
