Women's Clubs are Celebrated at the August Meeting

Guest Speaker Jane Garver presented a very enlightening program about women's clubs in the Petoskey area over the last hundred years plus. Many of the clubs, started between 1910 and 1920, focused on prohibition and women's suffrage. Some of the Petoskey groups Garver talked about included: the Daughters of the American Revolution, the Emmet County Equal Suffrage Club, the Women's Club, the Treble Clef Club, the Women's Foreign Missionary Society, and the AAUW. She also mentioned there were many special interest groups, from a book club to an arts study club.



The Petoskey Garden Club, still in existence today, was founded in 1943 by Dorothy Loveless, and this group helped pass the Petoskey Park Ordinance in 1973. For more information about these groups you can visit the Petoskey Historical Museum.
